

THE IB CONTINUUM

Teaching and learning in the IB grows from an understanding of education that celebrates the many ways people work together to construct meaning and make sense of the world. Students engage in asking (inquiry), doing (action) and thinking (reflection).



CURRICULUM STANDARDS

Our MYP curriculum at VIS is based on international curriculum standards, for each subject group. The understandings which make up these standards are developed through the framework of the IB MYP.

WHAT IS THE IB MYP?

The MYP (Middle Years Programme) aims to provide academic rigour and life skills for students aged 11 - 16. The MYP allows students to develop strengths and work on their weaknesses, through reflection on their learning experiences.

IB MYP SUBJECT GROUPS

The MYP at VIS is a programme which runs from Grade 6 to 10, framing five years of learning. Students will engage in learning through eight subject groups, in each year of the programme, as well as interdisciplinary learning across subject groups.

PROGRAMME CORE

- » **IB Learner Profile** - IB learners to strive to become inquirers, knowledgeable, thinkers, communicators, principled, open-minded, caring, risk-takers, balanced and reflective.
- » **Approaches to Learning** - Skills that have relevance across the curriculum and help students “learn how to learn”.
- » **Service as Action** - Learning by doing and experiencing, through which students strive to be caring members of the community.
- » **Personal Project** - The culminating experience of the MYP in which students undertake challenging, independent inquiry into an area of personal interest.
